Position Summary

The **Ifakara Health Institute**, through the **PMI Shinda (Defeat) Malaria project** is preparing to conduct a **Therapeutic Efficacy Study (TES)**, an antimalarial drug efficacy and safety study in Ngara DC. The study involves screening, enrolment, and treatment of children (6 months to 10 years old) with the first line and alternative antimalarial drugs and following them up for 28 or 42 days to assess treatment outcomes. The study is expected to run for six (6) months from mid-May to mid-October 2024.

The **Clinical Officer** will work under the directive of the Principal Investigator of the study. He/she will be involved in consenting, screening, recruiting, treating and assessing patient treatment outcomes. In addition, the successful candidates will be involved in the collection, analysis, recording, interpreting and storage of clinical data. The nature of the position requires a high level of commitment, ability to work under tight schedules and long hours.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Coordinate all clinical related activities at the study site.
- Manage all site administrative activities at the site
- Manage the data collection process by ensuring properly filled CRFs.
- Ensure consent processes are well observed per SOPs.
