Abstracts should be submitted by the deadlines for consideration. Acceptance and mode of presentation of abstracts will be determined by the Conference Organizing Committee. Authors of accepted abstracts will be required to submit full papers which will be peer reviewed for publication in the conference proceedings. The abstract should have the following structure: Title of the abstract, authors' names and institutional affiliations (list multiple affiliations one below the other) and mark each with a superscript "1" "2". Provide Background, Objective, Methods, Findings and Conclusion. Mark the name of the corresponding author with an asterisk (*). Provide Email address of the corresponding author. An abstract must not exceed 300 words using Times New Roman 12. Abstract submission deadline: 30th July 2017, 23h59 EAT
