Ifakara Health Institute seeks a qualified **Electrician** to join our team at the Ifakara branch in Morogoro. The successful candidate will be responsible for installing and repairing ordinary electrical controls, wiring, and lighting systems, working from a technical aspect. The candidate must hold a certified electrician qualification from a recognized technical college and have proven experience working with both basic and advanced electrical systems.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Assemble, install, test, and maintain electrical or electric wiring, equipment, apparatus, and fixtures using hand tools and power tools.
- Inspect electrical systems, equipment, and components to identify hazards, defects, and the need for adjustment or repair, and to ensure compliance with codes.
- Test electrical system and continuity of circuits in electrical wiring, equipment, and fixtures, using testing devices such as ohmmeters, voltmeters, and oscilloscopes, to ensure compatibility and safety of the system.
- Service, clean, and inspect equipment periodically following established PMs (Preventative Maintenance).
- Create notifications and follow up on repairs.
- Perform any additional task assigned by Supervisor.
