- Supervise data collection processes, ensuring accuracy and reliability. Perform statistical analyses using epidemiological methods and tools. Interpret results and contribute to scientific knowledge through evidence generation.
- Prepare technical reports, research manuscripts, and policy briefs. Present findings to stakeholders, including policymakers, donors, and academic audiences. Contribute to publications in peer-reviewed journals and conference proceedings.
